After removing the contents, please rinse then drop off your cartons of eggshells to the LCE office.

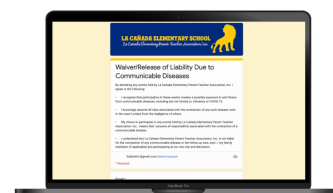
Our Confetti Eggs Chairperson will pick them up and make sure they're filled with confetti made of shredded, recycled paper from the teacher workroom.

New Travel Guidelines

No More Automatic Quarantine for Unvaccinated Students

Just in time to plan for the Thanksgiving holiday, the 7-10 day automatic quarantine for all unvaccinated LCUSD students (who travel outside of California) has been eliminated.

"Currently, the ONLY travel requirement is that all out-of-country travelers test negative for COVID-19 within 72 hours of the return flight home," said Superintendent Wendy Sinnette of the new travel guidance adopted at LCUSD's last school board meeting.
