So Easy: Pull Up, Release, Pour Out, Rinse, Done

This probably isn't news to confetti egg pros. But if you're daunted by the prospect of precisely cracking open a raw egg... Meet the egg cracker topper!

After removing the contents, simply drop off your cartons of eggshells to the LCE office.

Our Confetti Eggs Chairperson will pick them up and make sure they're filled with confetti made of shredded, recycled paper from the teacher workroom.

- Crown an egg with the cracker
- Gently pull up the top of the cracker
- Gently release the top (may need to repeat)
- Pour out the egg contents
- Rinse the inside
- Drop off at the front office

There are many different varieties of egg cracker toppers. Some, however, are designed specifically for soft boiled eggs and don't work well with raw ones. Here's <u>one</u> we like for confetti eggs.

New Travel Guidelines No More Automatic Quarantine for Unvaccinated Students

Just in time to plan for the Thanksgiving holiday, the 7-10 day automatic quarantine for all unvaccinated LCUSD students (who travel outside of California) has been eliminated.

"Currently, the ONLY travel requirement is that all out-of-country travelers test negative for COVID-19 within 72 hours of the return flight home," summarized Superintendent Wendy Sinnette of the new travel guidance adopted at Monday's school board meeting.
